



GA Travel Grants

Graduate students who are **members of GA** and would like to present their scientific results during the 7th joint meeting of AFERP, ASP, GA, PSE and SIF in Athens, 3-8 August 2008, are eligible for a travel grant. The respective **application form** can be downloaded from the GA website. In addition to this form, applicants must submit the following documents for review together with their application:

- Letter of recommendation from the supervisor
- Curriculum vitae
- Photocopy of the valid student identity card or an equivalent certification from the University
- Abstract
- An estimation of the expected travel costs

It must be emphasized that **exclusively** those applicants whose application forms and documents are complete and whose abstracts have been accepted by the Scientific Committee will be considered for a travel grant. Keep in mind that the abstract will be reviewed two times and, therefore, has to be sent to the Scientific Committee **and** to the GA Travel Grant Committee. Awardees will be notified immediately after completion of the reviewing process.

Only one travel grant will be granted per research group. An applicant can only once obtain a travel grant. The registration fee must be paid by the participant in any case. The number of grants is limited. The travel grant will **not** cover all expenses for the conference, travel and accommodation. The grants will be handed over at the meeting on presentation of **a copy of the travel ticket** clearly stating the fee. The travel grant will never surpass this fee, increased by a fixed amount to cover part of the expenses for registration and accommodation, and will usually be less.
